### **Organizational matters**

- CoSP is planned as scheduled

- <u>Health requirements</u> for entry into Egypt (Yellow fever requirements!):
- <u>COVID prevention and risk mitigation</u> measures
- Recommended hotels will have quick tests, medical staff, shuttle buses

### Civil society participation

- 367 representatives from 154 CSOs
- 261 in-person
- Written submissions (1500/2000 words, follow guidelines)
- UNCAC Coalition written submissions:
  - Regional priorities
  - UNCAC implementation parallel reports
  - WG's on ViC, AR, Environmental Crimes

### **CoSP 9 - Resolutions**

### Most negotiations take place this time in Vienna ahead of the CoSP

- Sharm El-Sheik Declaration (Egypt)
- Corruption prevention (Morocco)
- UNGASS Follow-up (Peru, Columbia, UAE)
- Training & Education (Russia)
- Strengthening UNCAC at the Regional Level (Angola)
- Enhancing Law-Enforcement Cooperation (KSA)
- Follow-up to Abu-Dhabi Declaration (UAE, Egypt)
- Beneficial Ownership / Asset Recovery (Nigeria) controversial and ongoing!



### **Objection to CSOs**

- Objection against 9 NGOs (8 by Turkey, 1 by Libya)
- Encouraging countries to be active and make statements on shrinking civic space
