Technical Assistance

Thank you, Chair.

In recent years, we have seen several successful examples of UNODC working closely with expert civil society organizations in the delivery of technical assistance. We encourage UNODC, other technical assistance providers, and donors to build on these positive experiences and to further enhance the involvement of non-governmental organizations, where appropriate, in technical assistance—both as providers and as beneficiaries.

We also encourage UNODC and States Parties to increase the level of information published on technical assistance requests and on projects being implemented. In particular, it would be helpful to share more detailed information on the assistance provided, including successes, lessons learned, the stakeholders involved, and the donors supporting specific initiatives. Greater transparency would allow other States and stakeholders to benefit from this information, whether by contributing to ongoing efforts or by requesting similar forms of assistance.

We again invite States Parties to strengthen the UNCAC Implementation Review Mechanism so that it can provide a stronger evidence base for strategic and impactful technical assistance.

Finally, we call on donors to provide additional resources for targeted, effective, and transparent technical assistance efforts. As a global civil society community, we stand ready to support these efforts.
