TI Portugal, as the Portuguese chapter of Transparency International, is active in numerous areas of civic intervention, helping to strengthen integrity systems by reporting irregularities and crimes, monitoring public policies and implementing innovative tools, instruments and methodologies to prevent corruption and the misappropriation of public funds. We would like to contribute in areas and issues that we have extensive expertise by helping to strengthen: the fight against money laundering through the transparency of beneficial owners; the fight against transnational corruption; integrity in politics and the mechanisms to prevent



conflicts of interest; lobbying regulation; transparency in public procurement and in the allocation of European funds; transparency and anti-corruption practices in the public sector; the implementation of anti-money laundering and anti-terrorist financing systems, fighting for the application of the law and regulations in different sectors and whistleblowers protection.


