



### **Open contracting delivers results**


- Ecuador: more than 8,000 emergency procedures worth a total of \$247 million are available, and 24,000 officials have been trained in emergency procurement
- **Ukraine:** over **\$2bn** saved, **thousands of new businesses** entered the supply chain, and **perceptions of corruption have halved**.
- **Colombia**: improved **700,000+ school meals a day** for Bogota's schoolchildren, breaking up a price-fixing scheme providing poor service at high prices.

### Procurement pros embrace open contracting

- "When you don't know what to do, you must do the right thing. What was good for the country was that there be open data." Silvana Vallejo, director of SERCOP, Ecuador
- "Rather than trying to seize as much control as possible, the only way to address such a situation is to build a stakeholder coalition around open and clear contracting data." Vasyl Zadvornyy, Chief Executive Officer, State-owned enterprise ProZorro, Ukraine
- "Open data helped raise certain red flags, such as the need to diversify supply chains. It also re-informed what we've been saying for years, how important it is to educate our public buyers." Laura Kuoraitė, senior advisor, procurement agency, Lithuania

- Key planning documents not provided
- Non-public bid opening
- Short notice to bidders
- Vague description of supply terms
- High number of contract awards to one bidder
- Bidder that has never bid previously wins tender
- Supplier address
  - P.O.Box
  - Similarities btw suppliers


- Large difference between contract award and final contract amount
- Supplier receives multiple single source contracts
- Final price is higher than industry average

- Change orders issued after contract award on line item requirements
- Change orders to increase price substantially (or multiple by a smaller amount)
- Payment without delivery of service



VISUALIZES CONTRACTS BY TYPE, TIME FRAME, DATE SIGNED, AMOUNT


