- New legislation in the USA will require all federal contracts above USD\$500,000 to disclose the beneficial ownership of contract awardees
- UK Public Procurement Green Paper (Dec 2020) will require all foreign companies bidding on UK contracts to disclose their beneficial ownership
- Since 2017 Slovakia has required all recipients of public funds of more than €100,000 to disclose their beneficial owners

- Buying quickly and safely has been harder than ever during this pandemic for government and business
- There is an opportunity at the UNGASS to support the global effort to ensure government has the information it needs, much faster, to make informed decisions about who it does business with
- This means ensuring that, as a minimum, all agencies in government can access beneficial ownership data at speed and in usable formats
