#### **Brief summary of updates, decisions, and next steps**

##### **1. Welcoming of newly elected board members Kristen Robinson and Wana Alamsyah**

##### **2. Update by the MD on recent developments**

The MD informed that UNODC published a call for side events during the 10th Conference of the States Parties (CoSP10). The deadline for civil society organizations to apply is 12 August.

##### **3. Updates from CCC members**

Kristen Robinson reported that France has announced to table a resolution on public procurement during CoSP10. Chanez Mensous gave an update on the Lebanese ill-gotten gains case; the judicial investigation is now open in several countries, including France and Luxembourg and there will be procedural hearings on the temporary confiscation of Salameh's assets.

##### **4. Joint Meeting between three UNCAC Coalition Working Groups**

Gillian Dell announced that the Working Groups on Grand Corruption, Asset Recovery and Victims of Corruption will hold a joint meeting in September to discuss advocacy towards CoSP10 focusing on victims' remedies.

## **5. Internal procedures**

- The CCC voted for extending the terms of its current four officers until September.
- The Vienna hub team is working with an external consultant to review the Coalition's governance policies.
