Coalition Coordination Committee (CCC) Online Meeting Summary

1. Approval of Minutes:

The CCC approved the minutes from the previous CCC call (25 September 2025).

2. Follow-Up on Previous Action Points:

The MD reported progress since the last meeting, including outreach for candidacies for CCC leadership roles and updates on the CCC elections:

- The elections were successfully conducted: Mukhtar Ahmad Ali was elected Chair of the Coalition, and Naomi Roht-Arriaza and Rachel Davies Vice-Chairs.

3. CoSP11 - Logistic (Updates and Q&A)

The MD provided a comprehensive update on CoSP11 logistics and preparations, including travel and accommodation, side events and written submissions, media and communications, and preparatory and coordination meetings.

4. CoSP11 – Update & Discussion of Advocacy Plans and Possible Contributions by CCC Members

The MD and the Hub Team presented an overview of resolutions, advocacy priorities, and ways CCC members may contribute. The Hub team also presented on the current resolutions landscape and on a structured approach to address priority resolutions.

The CCC was invited to review resolutions and suggest language, identify supportive government positions and contacts, participate in advocacy calls, and engage delegations in their regions to amplify messaging.

5. Updates from Vienna Hub and CCC Members

The MD and CCC members shared updates, including on Coalition branding.

6. Any Other Issues

Alternates in CCC meetings: The possibility of allowing alternates to attend CCC meetings was raised.

SWANA regional coordinator vacancy: The MD addressed the ongoing vacancy in the SWANA regional coordinator role, alongside the current model of regional coordination, upon suggestion of the CCC member representing the region. The MD noted that the position is likely to remain unfilled in the near term due to financial constraints. Possible interim arrangements for regional coordination were briefly discussed.

With time constraints and no further issues open for discussion, the meeting was closed.
